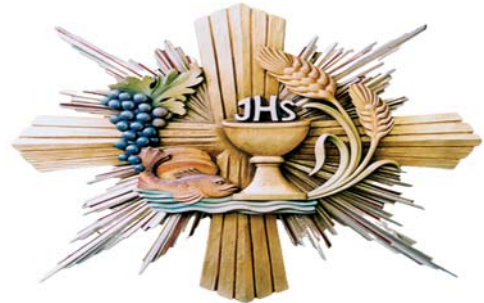

SUNDAY REFLECTION

Today, Jesus gives us two parables about farming: the parable of the scattered seed, and the parable of the mustard seed. These were images that people listening to Jesus could relate to, since most of them spent their days in the fields planting, watering and reaping. Our Lord told these parables using something they knew —agricultural work— in order to teach them something they did not know about: the Kingdom of God!

Indeed, Jesus teaches something about his spiritual Kingdom. In the first parable He says: “This is how it is with the kingdom of God; it is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land” (Mk 4:26). And He introduces the second by saying, “To what shall we compare the kingdom of God...? It is like a mustard seed” (Mk 4:30).

Most of us today have little in common with those farmers; yet these parables can powerfully resonate in our modern minds because we can still understand quite a lot about planting, watering and harvesting, and somehow, we sense through his words, that God has planted something in our hearts that will not allow us to move completely away from him.

What is the Kingdom of God? It is “Jesus himself”, as Pope Benedict XVI reminds us. And our soul “is the essential location of the Kingdom of God”. God wants to live and grow inside us. If we seek God's wisdom and obey his commands, our life will become as steady as a rock and acquire a power that we can barely imagine.

If we patiently correspond to his grace, his divine life will definitely grow in the soul the way seed grows in the field or, as the medieval mystic, Meister Eckhart, has beautifully expressed: “The seed of God is in us. Given an intelligent and hard-working farmer it will thrive and grow up to God, whose seed it is; and accordingly, its fruits will be God nature. Pear seeds grow into pear trees, nut seeds into nut trees, and God seed into God.”

APOSTOLAT POLSKI

ZAREJESTRUJ SIĘ DO NASZEJ PARAFII



Serdecznie witamy nowych członków parafii i zapraszamy do rejestracji w Biurze Parafialnym. Rejestracji w kościele św. Jadwigi można dokonać pobierając formularze w sekretariacie lub przy wejściu do kościoła. Wypełniony formularz można przesłać pocztą na plebanię, wrzucić do koszyka lub dostarczyć osobiście do Biura Parafialnego. Jedną z najważniejszych rzeczy, którą powinni zrobić mieszkańcy parafii, jest rejestracja. Rejestracja w parafii nie tylko czyni Cię bardziej częścią rodziny kościoła św. Jadwigi, ale także daje Tobie i Twojej rodzinie szansę na bycie usłyszonym w parafii.

KATECHIZM KOŚCIOŁA KATOLICKIEGO

Jakie znaczenie dla chrześcijan ma Nowy Testament?

W NOWYM TESTAMENCIE -> OBJAWIENIE Boże osiąga swoją pełnię. Cztery Ewangelie, według: Mateusza, Marka, Łukasza i Jana, stanowią rdzeń Pisma Świętego i najcenniejszy skarb Kościoła. Poprzez nie Syn Boży ukazuje się taki, jaki jest i spotyka się z nami. Z Dziejów Apostolskich dowiadujemy się o początkach Kościoła i o działaniu Ducha Świętego. W Listach każdy z aspektów życia ludzkiego ukazany zostaje w świetle Chrystusa. Apokalipsa zawiera wizję końca czasów.

ROZWAŻANIE NA NIEDZIELE

Dzisiaj Jezus przywołuje dwa obrazy o wielkiej mocy dochowej: przypowieść o wroście ziarna i przypowieść o ziarnku gorczycy. Są to obrazy z codziennego życia, które mogą się wydawać bliskie ludziom, którzy słuchają, przyzwyczajonym do siania, podlewania i zbierania. Jezus wykorzystuje coś im znajomego, uprawę roli, by zilustrować coś, co nie jest dla nich takie oczywiste: Królestwo Boże.

W rzeczywistości Pan wyjawia coś ze swojego duchowego królestwa. W pierwszej przypowieści mówi im: «Z królestwem Bożym dzieje się tak, jak gdyby ktoś nasienie wrzucił w ziemię» (Mk 4,26). Przytacza też drugą przypowieść słowami: «Z czym porównamy królestwo Boże (...) Jest ono jak ziarnko gorczycy» (Mk 4,30).

Większość z nas niewiele ma wspólnego z ludźmi z epoki Jezusa, lecz przypowieści te przemawiają do nowoczesnych umysłów, gdyż w obrazie siania ziarna, podlewania i zbierania wyczuwamy, że Jezus mówi do nas: Bóg zasiał coś boskiego w naszych ludzkich sercach.

Czym jest Królestwo Boże? «Jest samym Jezusem», przypomina Benedykt XVI. A nasza dusza «jest tym miejscem, w którym znajduje się Królestwo Boże». Bóg pragnie żyć i wzrastać w naszym wnętrzu! Szukajmy mądrości Boga i słuchajmy wewnętrznych Jego podszeptów: jeśli to będziemy czynić, nasze życie nabierze mocy i intensywności, jaką trudno sobie wyobrazić.

Jeśli cierpliwie będziemy współpracować z jego łaską, jego boskie życie będzie wzrastać w naszej duszy, tak jak w polu rośnie ziarno, i jak średniowieczny mistyk Meister Eckhart pięknie wyraził: «Ziarno Boga jest w nas. Jeśli ziemię uprawia roztropny i pracowity rolnik, wszędzie ono i będzie wzrastać ku Bogu, którego ziarnem jest, a zatem każde jego owoce będą miały boską naturę. Z ziarna gruszy wyrastają grusze, z ziaren orzecha – orzechy, a z ziaren Bożych- Bóg».
