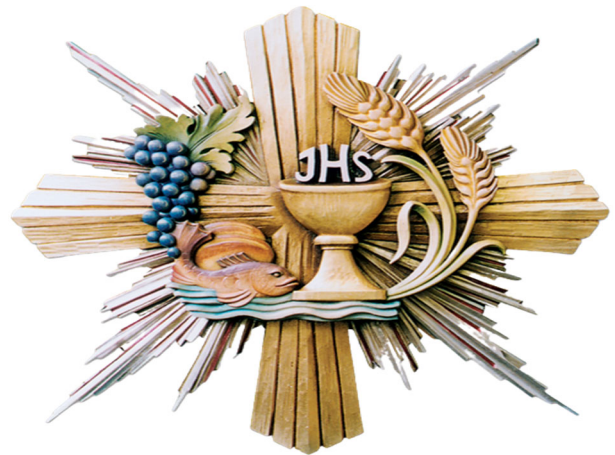

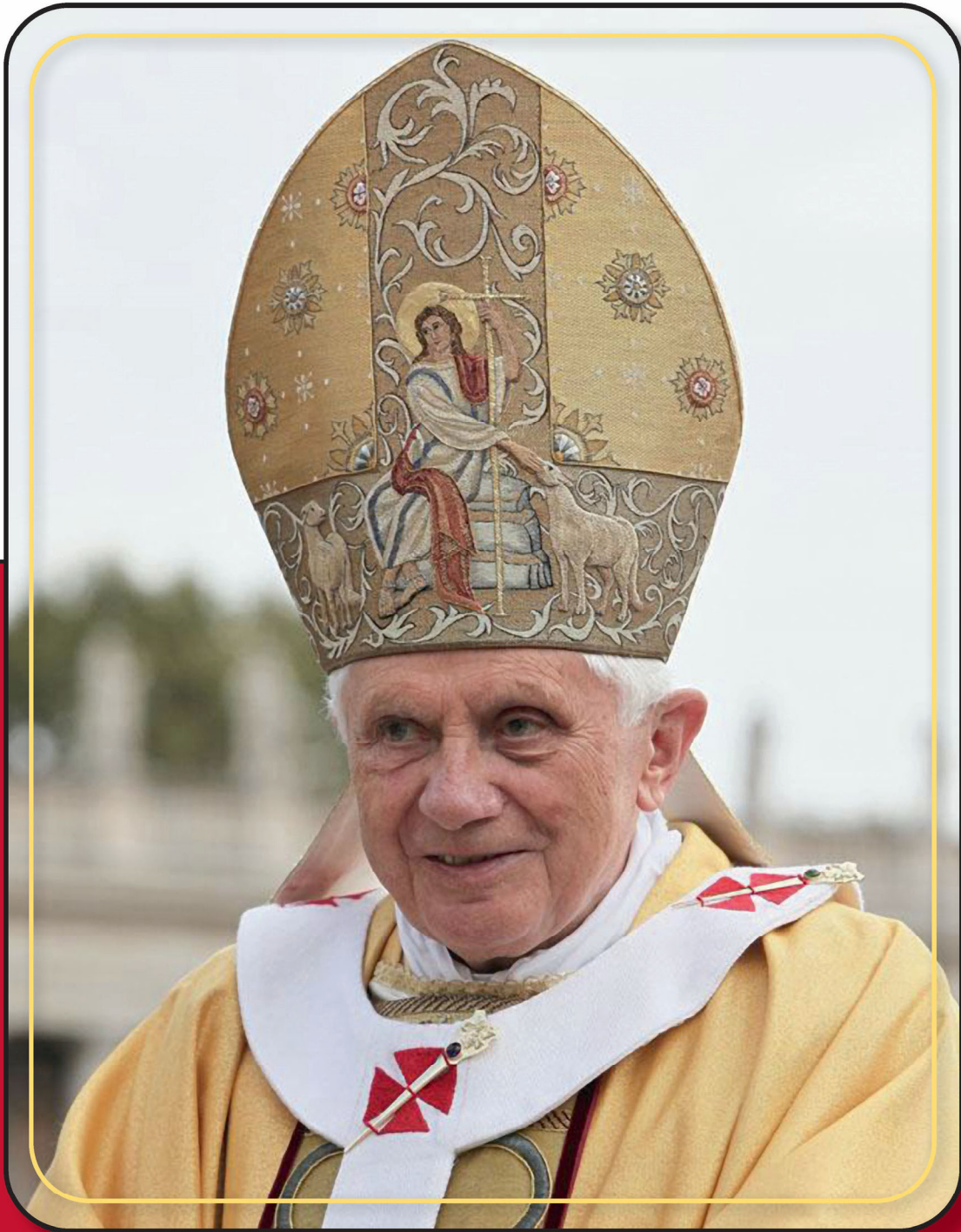

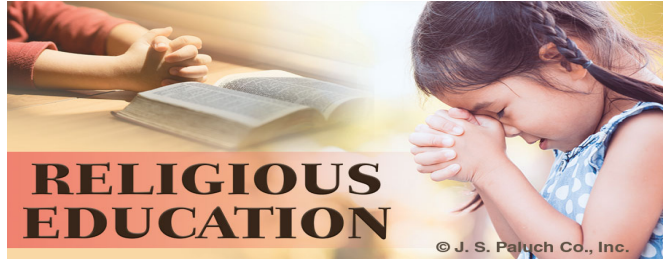

It is a process that continues through one's life and ideally should reflect in one's daily life.

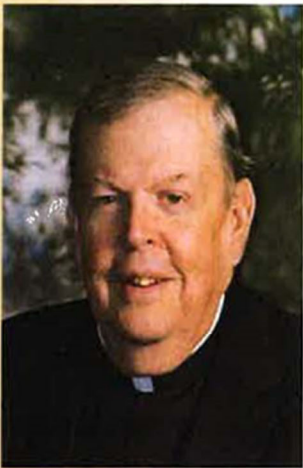
