

## Rozważanie na niedzielę

Dzisiaj, modląc się Jezus uczy nas się modlić. Dobrze przyjrzyjmy się postawie, jakiej nas uczy. Jezus Chrystus często doświadcza potrzeby spotkania się twarzą w twarz z Ojcem. Mówi o tym w sposób szczególny w swojej Ewangelii Św. Łukasz. O czym rozmawiali tamtego dnia? Tego nie wiemy. Ale jednak przy innej okazji dotarł do nas fragment rozmowy między Nim i Jego Ojcem. Kiedy modlił się w czasie chrztu nad Jordanem: «a z nieba odezwał się głos: 'Tyś jest mój Syn umiłowany, w Tobie mam upodobanie'» (Łk 3,22). To zdanie z bardzo czułego osobistego dialogu. Kiedy jeden z uczniów w dzisiejszej Ewangelii, widząc skupienie Jezusa prosi, aby nauczył ich rozmowy z Bogiem, Jezus mu odpowiada: «Kiedy się modlicie, mówcie: Ojcze, niech się święci Twoje imię...» (Łk 11,2). Modlitwa jest synowską rozmową z Ojcem, który nas kocha do szaleństwa. Czy Święta Teresa z Ávila nie nazywała modlitwy "intymną relacją przyjaźni": «być często sam na sam z tym, o którym wiemy, że nas kocha»?

Benedykt XVI odnajduje «znaczenie, dla którego Łukasz umieszcza Ojcze nasz w kontekście osobistej modlitwy Jezusa. On w ten sposób sprawia, że jesteśmy uczestnikami Jego modlitwy, prowadzi nas w głąb dialogu miłości Trójcy i można powiedzieć, że zanosí nasze ludzkie sprawy do serca Boga».

Jest bardzo znaczące, że w potocznym języku modlitwa, której nas nauczył Jezus Chrystus streszcza się w tych dwóch słowach: «Ojcze Nasz». Chrześcijańska modlitwa jest ze wszech miar synowska.

Katolicka liturgia wkłada tę modlitwę w nasze usta w momencie przygotowania do przyjęcia Ciała i Krwi Jezusa Chrystusa. Siedem próśb i porządek, w jakim są one wypowiedziane poddają nam postawę, z jaką mamy przyjmować Eucharystię.

# CATECHISM of the CATHOLIC

Today, Jesus' praying teaches us how to pray. Let's pay great attention to what His attitude teaches us. Quite often, Jesus Christ feels the need to meet face-to-face with His Father. In his Gospel, Luke emphasizes this point.

What were they talking about that day? We do not know. On the other hand, somewhere else, we have located a fragment of a conversation between his Father and Himself. It was when He was baptized in the Jordan River, and He was in prayer, "And a voice came from heaven, 'You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased'" (Lk 3:22). It is an intermission in a tenderly affectionate dialogue.

When in today's Gospel, one of the disciples, realizing His meditation, begs Him to teach them how to speak with God, Jesus replies: "When you pray, say: Father, hallowed be your name..." (Lk 11:2). The prayer consists of a filial conversation with this Father that loves us madly. Teresa of Avila defined a prayer as "nothing else than a close sharing between friends; it means taking time frequently to be alone with him who we know loves us."

Benedict XVI finds it "significant for Luke to place the Lord's Prayer in the context of Jesus' personal prayer. Thus, he lets us share his praying; He takes us inside the intimate dialogue of Trinitarian love. In other words, He lifts our human weaknesses up to the very heart of God."

It is notable that, in our current language, the prayer Jesus Christ taught us may be encapsulated in these two single words: 'Our Father'. The Christian prayer is eminently filial.

The Catholic liturgy places this prayer upon our lips as we prepare to receive the Body and Blood of Christ. The seven petitions it contains, and their sequence, gives us an idea as to the kind of behavior we need to adopt when we receive the Holy Communion.

### *Why did God become man in Jesus?*

"For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven" (Nicene →CREED). [456-460] In Jesus Christ, God reconciled the world to himself and redeemed mankind from the imprisonment of sin. "God so loved the world that he gave his only-begotten Son" (Jn 3:16). In Jesus, God took on our mortal human flesh (→INCARNATION), shared our earthly lot, our sufferings, and our death, and became one like us in all things but sin. God is so great that he can become small. God is so powerful that he can make himself vulnerable and come to us as a defenseless child, so that we can love him. POPE BENEDICT XVI, December 24, 2005 77

### *What does it mean to say that Jesus Christ is at the same time true God and true man?*

In Jesus, God really became one of us and thus our brother; nevertheless, he did not cease to be God at the same time and thus our Lord. The Council of Chalcedon in the year 451 taught that the divinity and the humanity in the one person Jesus Christ are united together "without division or confusion". [464-467, 469] The Church grappled for a long time with the problem of how to express the relation between the divinity and humanity in Jesus Christ. Divinity and humanity are not in competition with each other, which would make Jesus only partially God and only partially man. Nor is it true that the divine and human in Jesus are confused. God took on a human body in Jesus; this was no mere appearance (Docetism), but he really became man. Nor are there two different persons in Christ, one human and one divine (Nestorianism). Nor is it true, finally, that in Jesus Christ the human nature was completely absorbed into the divine nature (Monophysitism). Contrary to all these heresies, the Church has adhered to the belief that Jesus Christ is at the same time true God and true man in one Person. The famous formula, "without division or confusion" (Council of Chalcedon) does not attempt to explain something that is too sublime for human understanding, but rather draws the boundaries, so to speak, of the faith. It indicates the "line" along which the mystery of the person of Jesus Christ can be investigated. He remained what he was, and he assumed what he was not. Roman Liturgy, January 1. Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority; but the Father who dwells in me does his works. Jn 14:10 Jesus is evident.


