
Today, we are presented with a Gospel with two seemingly unrelated parts. What does faith have to do with service? Without realizing it, we constantly reduce faith to concepts and ideas. We relegate Faith to simply believing in God. And we forget the relational dimension!

We cannot simply believe in God; it's not an idea. It's a living, personal, transformative relationship, and that changes everything. Faith is also living the Gospel. And living the Gospel, relating to the Lord, places us as servants, as servants of the Kingdom, in the words of Pope Leo XIV: "Priority must be given, then, to our relationship with the Lord and to cultivating our dialogue with him. In this way, he will make us his laborers and send us into the field of the world to bear witness to his Kingdom."

Thus, we understand why the Lord concludes His teaching in this way. When our hearts are flooded with the Lord's Love and our faith becomes a lived reality, sharing it is the least we can do (cf. Luke 17:10). Living as He offers us is not a way of repaying what we have received, for it is priceless; living as He offers us is the natural dynamism of a heart in love. "He accompanies me with his Spirit; he enlightens me and makes me an instrument of his love for others, for society and for the world" (Pope Leo XIV).

And that is our task as Christians: to be a light in the world, to make this gift we have received shine forth. Through our works and words at all times and in all places (cf. 2 Tim 4:2). This is possible not through concrete actions, but because our entire lives become living witnesses to the Love that has redeemed the world. "Lord, increase our faith" (Luke 17:5), and we will be your servants.


Respect Life Sunday
