



# Rozważanie na niedzielę

Dzisiaj, Jezus przypomina nam o tym, że trzeba «modlić się i nie ustawać» (Łk 18,1). Naucza czynami i słowami. Święty Łukasz jawi się nam jako głosiciel modlitwy Jezusa. Rzeczywiście w scenach z życia Jezusa, o których opowiadają nam natchnieni autorzy Pisma Świętego, tylko Święty Łukasz pokazuje nam Jezusa podczas modlitwy.

Jezus podczas Chrztu nad Jordanem, kiedy powołuje Dwunastu i podczas Przemienienia. Kiedy jeden z uczniów poprosił «Panie, naucz nas modlić się» (Łk 11,1), z Jego ust popłynęło Ojciec Nasz. Kiedy zapowiada zaparcie się Piotra mówi: «Ja prosiłem za tobą, żeby nie ustała twoja wiara» (Łk 22,32). Podczas ukrzyżowania: «Ojczy, przebacz im, bo nie wiedzą, co czynią» (Łk 23,34). Kiedy umiera na Krzyżu: «Panie, w ręce Twoje powierzam ducha mego», z Psalmu 31. Sam Pan Jezus jest przykładem modlitwy prośby, szczególnie w ogrodzie Getsemani, co zgodnie opisują wszyscy ewangelisci.

Można podawać przykłady na to, jak wznosić serce do Boga w różnych codziennych działaniach. Nie jest tym samym pracą intelektualną co fizyczną, być w kościele czy na boisku sportowym lub w domu, prowadzić auto w mieście czy na autostradzie. Nie tym samym jest także modlitwa prośby i dziękczynienia, adoracji i prześlągania, z samego rana i po całym męczącym dniu. Święty Josemaría Escrivá podaje taki przepis na modlitwę prośby: «Więcej uzyskuje ten, kto naprzykrza się z bliska... Dlatego zbliż się do Boga: daj usilnie do tego, by być świętym».

Wzorem modlitwy jest Maryja. W Kanie Galilejskiej swoją prośbą była w stanie przyspieszyć godzinę Jezusa i czas Jego cudów. Uczyniła to pełną miłości do nowożeńców i ufności w swojego Syna.

## October Polish American Heritage Month



Janusz M. Szlechta jest absolwentem Akademii Górniczo-Hutniczej w Krakowie. Potem skończył podyplomowe studia na Wydziale Dziennikarstwa na Uniwersytecie Warszawskim.

Dziennikarstwo stało się jego zawodem i pasją. Zaczynał w Radiu Kraków, potem kilka lat pracował w Tarnowskim Magazynie Informacyjnym "TeMI". W latach 80. był dziennikarzem wydawanego w Krakowie tygodnika "Wieści". Na początku lat 90. podjął pracę w "Gazecie Krakowskiej".

W sierpniu 1995 roku wyjechał do Stanów Zjednoczonych i tam mieszka do dziś. 13 października 1995 r. podjął pracę w "Nowym Dzienniku" w Nowym Jorku - największej i najbardziej prestiżowej polonijnej gazecie w USA - i pracował w nim do stycznia 2016 roku jako szef działu polonijnego, zajmując się sprawami dotyczącymi życia Polaków w USA i w świecie. Żyjąc wśród amerykańskiej Polonii, stara się jej służyć nie tylko swoim pisaniem, ale i działalnością społeczną. Do tej pory wydał sześć książek, m.in. : zbiór wierszy "Pieśń niedokończona", wybór wywiadów z Polakami w USA "Widziane stąd" oraz wybór wywiadów z Polakami rozszanymi po świecie zatytułowaną "Widziane stamtąd".

Today, Jesus reminds us about the necessity “to pray always without becoming weary” (Lk 18:1). He teaches with His deeds and with His words. St. Luke appears before us as the evangelist of Jesus' prayers. Quite so! In some of the scenes, where the authors inspired in the Holy Scriptures depict Jesus' life, only Luke presents Him in the act of praying.

The Lord is a model of the petition prayer. During Jesus' Baptism in the river Jordan, when choosing the Twelve and at the Transfiguration. When a disciple asks Him “Lord, teach us to pray” (Lk 11:1) and from His lips comes out the Lord's Prayer. When He announces His negations to Peter: “I have prayed that your own faith may not fail” (Lk 22:32). At the crucifixion: “Then Jesus said, ‘Father, forgive them, they know not what they do’” (Lk 23:34). When He dies in the Cross: “Father, into your hands I commend my spirit” (Lk 23:46). After the description of all evangelists, the same Lord is a model of the petition prayer, especially at the Gethsemane garden.

—I could point out how I will raise my heart towards God during different activities, because intellectual work and manual labor are not the same; being in church or in a sports field or at home; driving in a city or on a turnpike; there is a difference between petition and gratitude prayers: between adoration and pleading forgiveness; early in the morning, late, after a whole day's work. St. Josemaria Escrivá gives us a recipe for the petition prayer: “More is achieved by whoever goes up closer to plead... That is why you must get close to God and be intent on becoming a saint.”

The Virgin Mary is a model of prayer, also of petition prayer. At Cana of Galilee she was able to advance Jesus' timing, the time of the miracles, with her petition, full of love for those newly weds and full of trust in her Son.


### World Mission Sunday
