Rozważanie na niedzielę

Dzisiaj z uwagą czytamy Ewangelię Św. Łukasza. To przypowieść skierowana do naszych serc. To słowa życia obnażające naszą ludzką i chrześcijańską kondycję, która powinna opierać się na pokorze wynikającej ze świadomości tego, że jesteśmy grzesznikami («Boże! Miej listość dla mnie, grzesznika!»: Łk 18,13), i z miłosierdzia i dobroci naszego Boga («Każdy bowiem, kto się wywyższa, będzie poniżony, a kto się uniaża, będzie wywyższony»: Łk 18,14).

Dzisiaj, bardziej niż kiedykolwiek paląca jest potrzeba odkrycia nas samych i podkreślenia uwalniającej mocy Boga dla naszego życia, a także dla naszego społeczeństwa. To najważniejsza postawa, aby Prawda naszej wiary dotarła z całą siłą do współczesnych kobiet i mężczyzn. Potrójną osią naszej ewangelicznej wiarygodności są: moc, miłość i trzeźwe myślenie (cf. 2Tm 1,7).

Moc, aby poznawać Słowo Boże i stosować je w naszym życiu, pomimo trudności. W naszych czasach szczególnie trzeba kłaść nacisk na tę cechę, gdyż wiele jest samozakłamania w świecie, który nas otacza. Święty Wincenty z Lerynu ostrzegał nas: «Gdy tylko z jakiego błędu zgnilizna okazywać się zacznie i kraść niektóre Bożego prawa słowa na swoją obronę a wyklądać je fałszywie i zdradliwie» (Commonitorium - Pamiętnik Św. Wincentego z Lerynu).

Miłość, aby patrzeć z czułością, to znaczy, oczami Boga, na osobę lub na zdarzenie, którego doświadczamy. Jan Paweł II zachęca nas do «pogłębiania Duchowości komunii», która, oznacza «spojrzenie utkwione w tajemnicy Trójcy Świętej, która zamieszkuje w nas i której blask należy dostrzegać także w obliczach braci żyjących wokół nas».

I w końcu, trzeźwe myślenie, aby przekazywać Prawdę współczesnym językiem, prawdziwie wcielając Słowo Boże w nasze życie: «uwierzą naszym czynkom bardziej aniżeli jakiegokolwiek mowie» (Święty Jan Chryzostom).





SUNDAY REFLECTIONS

Today, Jesus reminds us about the necessity “to pray always without becoming weary” (Lk 18:1). He teaches with His deeds and with His words. St. Luke appears before us as the evangelist of Jesus' prayers. Quite so! In some of the scenes, where the authors inspired in the Holy Scriptures depict Jesus' life, only Luke presents Him in the act of praying.

The Lord is a model of the petition prayer. During Jesus' Baptism in the river Jordan, when choosing the Twelve and at the Transfiguration. When a disciple asks Him “Lord, teach us to pray” (Lk 11:1) and from His lips comes out the Lord's Prayer. When He announces His negations to Peter: “I have prayed that your own faith may not fail” (Lk 22:32). At the crucifixion: “Then Jesus said, ‘Father, forgive them, they know not what they do’” (Lk 23:34). When He dies in the Cross: “Father, into your hands I commend my spirit” (Lk 23:46). After the description of all evangelists, the same Lord is a model of the petition prayer, especially at the Gethsemane garden.

—I could point out how I will raise my heart towards God during different activities, because intellectual work and manual labor are not the same; being in church or in a sports field or at home; driving in a city or on a turnpike; there is a difference between petition and gratitude prayers: between adoration and pleading forgiveness; early in the morning, late, after a whole day's work. St. Josemaria Escrivá gives us a recipe for the petition prayer: “More is achieved by whoever goes up closer to plead... That is why you must get close to God and be intent on becoming a saint.”

The Virgin Mary is a model of prayer, also of petition prayer. At Cana of Galilee she was able to advance Jesus' timing, the time of the miracles, with her petition, full of love for those newly weds and full of trust in her Son.


