Today, the Gospel clearly urges us to become witness to Christ. And it invites us in two different ways, which, apparently, may look contradictory: the salt and the light.

The salt cannot be seen but can be perceived; it can be tasted, relished. There are many persons that “can hardly be perceived”, as they are like “little ants” working and doing good all the time. At their side one can savor peace, serenity and joy. As it is said at present, their “radiations” are good.

Light, instead, cannot be hidden. There are persons that “can be seen from afar”: Mother Therese of Calcutta, the Pope, a parish's rector. They hold important positions because of their natural leadership or because of their concrete priesthood. They are “brought into the limelight”. As today's Gospel says «on top of a mountain» or on a “lamp stand” (cf. Mt 5:14-15).

We are all called to be salt and light. For over 30 years of His hidden life in Nazareth, Jesus Himself was also “salt”. It is being said that, once, while he was playing, someone asked St. Aloysius Gonzaga what would he do if he knew that within a few minutes he would die. “I would keep on playing”, he answered. He would go on carrying out his normal every-day's life, and making life pleasant for his play pals.

It may be we are called to be light. We are quite clearly so when we avow our own faith in difficult moments. Martyrs are great luminaries. And in certain environments, today, the mere fact of attending Mass may be the subject of jokes and general mockery. Going to Mass is already being “light”. And light is always detected and seen, no matter how small it may be. A little light may change the night.

Let us pray to the Lord for one another that we always know how to be salt. And how to be light, if need be. That our daily chores are carried out in such a way that through our good deeds people may praise our Father who is in Heaven (cf. Mt 5:16).

Rozważanie na niedzielę

Dzisiaj, Ewangelia ma dla nas wzniosłe wezwanie, abyśmy byli świadkami Chrystusa. Zaprasza nas, żebyśmy czynili to na dwa, pozornie sprzeczne ze sobą sposoby: jako sól i jako światło.

Sól jest niewidoczna, ale wyczuwalna w smaku. Jest wiele osób, które nie zwracają na siebie uwagi. Są jak „mróweczki”, które nie przestają pracować i czynić dobrze. W ich obecności odczuwamy pokój, spokój ducha i radość. Mają, jak to się mówi: „pozytywne wibracje”.

Światła nie da się ukryć. Są ludzie, których „widać z daleka”: Świętej Teresa z Kalkuty, Papież czy wiejski proboszcz. Zajmują ważne stanowiska z uwagi a swoje cechy przywódcze lub określoną posługę. Znajdują się „na świeczniku”. Jak mówi dzisiejsza Ewangelia, «na górze » lub «na świeczniku» (por. Mt 5,14.15).

Wszyscy jesteśmy wezwani do bycia solą i światłem. Sam Pan Jezus był „solą” przez trzydzieści lat swojego ukrytego życia w Nazarecie. Podobno święty młodzianin, Alojzy Ludwik Gonzaga, zapytany podczas zabawy, co by zrobił, gdyby wiedział, że niebawem umrze, odpowiadał: «Bawiłbym się dalej». Nadal żyłby normalnie, jak codzień, umilając czas towarzyszom zabawy.

Czasem jesteśmy wezwani do bycia światłem. Stajemy się nim, kiedy w chwilach trudnych wyznajemy naszą wiarę. Męczennicy byli wielkimi „światlikami”. Dzisiaj, już sam fakt chodzenia na Mszę św. jest powodem do drwin. Już samo uczęszczanie do kościoła to bycie „światłem”. A światło, choćby najmniejsze, jest zawsze widoczne. Małe światelko jest w stanie rozświetlić ciemną noc.

Prośmy za siebie nawzajem Pana, abyśmy zawsze potrafili być solą, a także światłem, jeśli zajdzie taka potrzeba. Niech nasze potępowanie na codzień będzie takie, aby ludzie widzieli nasze dobre uczynki i chwalili Ojca naszego, który jest w niebie (por. Mt 5,16).


