



Father Michał Sopoćko

Father Michał Sopoćko was a Polish Catholic priest and professor at Vilnius University. He is best known as the spiritual director of Saint Faustina Kowalska. He was born on November 1, 1888. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1914. During World War I, he served as a military chaplain. Later, he became a professor of pastoral theology at Vilnius University. Father Sopoćko played a crucial role in spreading the Divine Mercy devotion, particularly by supporting and promoting the message contained in the Diary of Saint Faustina Kowalska. He was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI in 2008. He died on February 15, 1975, and was buried in the parish cemetery in Białystok.



His relics are now enshrined in our church beneath the Divine Mercy image, alongside the relics of Saint Faustina.

We commemorate him in the liturgy each year on February 15.
