LIST KSIĘDZA PROBOSZCZA



Drodzy Parafianie i Przyjaciele Kościoła Św. Jadwigi,

Dzisiaj, Jezus ukazuje nam dwie rzeczywistości, które Go określają: że On jest Tym, który zna Ojca w całej głębi i że On jest «cichy i pokornego serca» (Mt 11,29). Możemy również odkryć w tym dwie postawy niezbędne, by móc zrozumieć i przeżyć to, co Jezus nam oferuje: prostotę i pragnienie zbliżenia się do Niego.

W Ojcu, Jezus znajduje swój odpoczynek i Jego pokój może być schronieniem dla wszystkich tych, którzy zostali skrzywdzeni przez życie: «Przyjdźcie do mnie wszyscy, którzy utrudzeni i obciążeni jesteście, a ja was pokrzepię» (Mt 11,28). Jezus jest pokorny, a pokora jest siostrą prostoty. Kiedy uczymy się bycia szczęśliwymi poprzez prostotę, wiele komplikacji się rozwiązuje, wiele potrzeb znika i w końcu możemy odpocząć. Jezus zaprasza nas do podążania za nim; nie oszukuje nas: bycie z Nim jest dźwiganiem swojego brzemienia, wzięciem na siebie wymagań, które stawia miłość. Nie będzie nam oszczędzone cierpienie, ale jego ciężar jest lekki, bo nasz ból nie będzie przez nas pojmowany egoistycznie, tylko będziemy cierpieć tyle, ile jest to konieczne i przezwycięzymy to przez miłość i z pomocą Ducha. Poza tym, nie zapominajmy, że «przeciwności, które cierpi się dla Boga złączone są nadzieją» (św. Efreem).

LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR



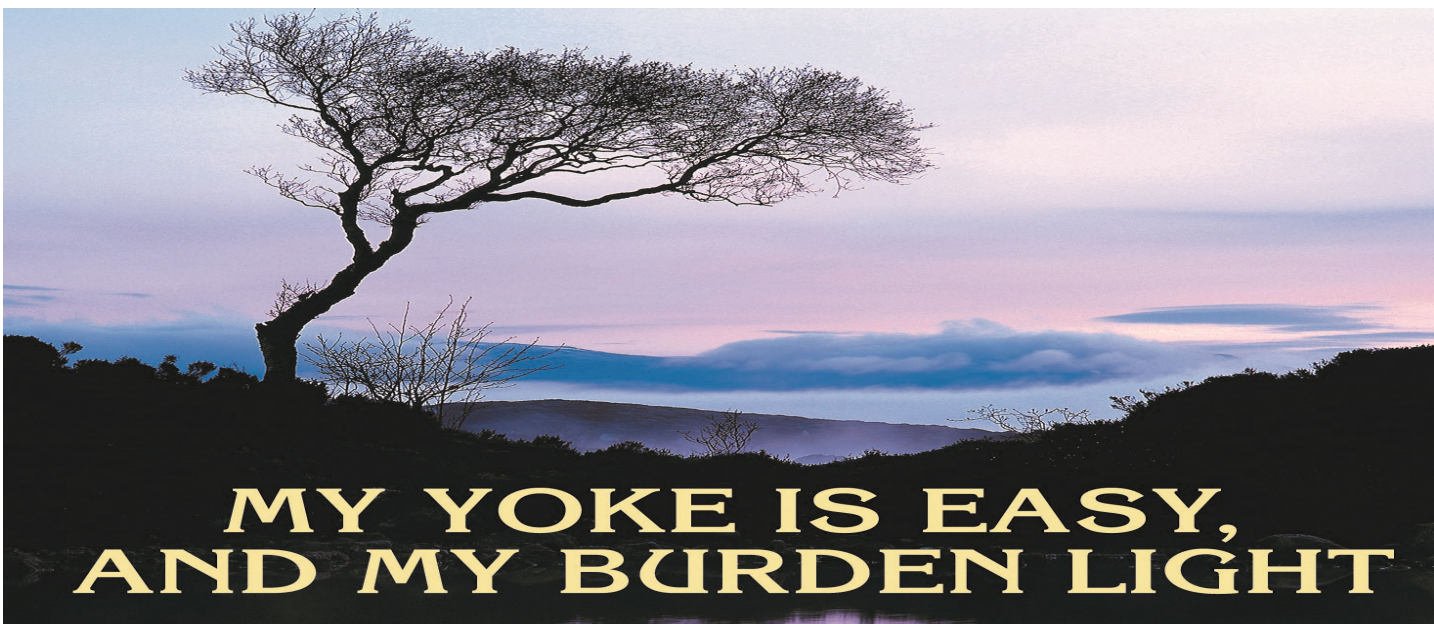
Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Hedwig's Church,

Today, two realities define Jesus in this Gospel: no one knows the Father except him, and He is «gentle and humble of heart» (Mt 11:29). We can also discern in this Gospel two attitudes that we require to properly understand and enjoy what Jesus is offering us: simplicity and the desire to get close to Him.

Jesus finds his own rest in his Father, and his peace may be the safe haven sought by those life has mistreated: «Come to me, all you who work hard and who carry heavy burdens and I will refresh you» (Mt 11:28). Jesus is humble and humility is the sister of simplicity. When we learn how to be happy through simplicity, many complications are dispelled, many needs disappear, and we can rest, at long last. Jesus invites us to follow him; and He is not deceiving us: to be with him is to take his yoke upon us, to assume the demands of his love. We shall not be spared any suffering, but his load will be light, and our suffering will not be a consequence of our own selfishness but, because of love and with the Spirit's help, we shall suffer only what we should and no more. Furthermore, let us not forget that, «the tribulations we suffer for God are softened by the hope» (St. Ephraem).

MASSES RESUMED AT 33% CAPACITY

- Daily and weekend Masses are resumed. Morning Mass at 9 o'clock has been permanently removed from the schedule.
- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass remains in effect.
- Masks must be worn while at Mass.
- Holy Communion will be distributed after the Mass. Eucharist taken in hand is recommended.
- Collection will be taken by Ushers practicing safety guidelines. You can also make your donations by placing it in the baskets that will be at the door of the church. Use of on-line giving is encouraged.
- There will be no invitation to exchange the sign of peace.
- Rectory Office is open during regular office hours: (from 9 am –till 5pm) however parishioners are urged to make calls and limit visits (must wear masks)
- Church will be open for a private prayer daily from 9am-7pm.
- Parishioners should leave church gradually, not all at once. This will avoid a crowd gathering in the lobby or outside the church.

SAINT MARIA GORETTI (1890-1902)

July 6

Does anything match a mother's pride in her children? First Communions, confirmations, graduations, weddings: how these delight a mother's heart! Imagine, then, Assunta Goretti, the only mother ever to attend her child's canonization! In poverty-stricken rural Italy, widowed Assunta tended fields for the Serenelli family, whose eighteen-year-old son, Alessandro, propositioned her barely twelve-year-old Maria; then, when she resisted, crying, "It is a sin! God forbids it!" he stabbed her fourteen times. As she lay dying, Maria assured the attending priest, "Yes, I forgive Alessandro! I want him to be in Paradise with me someday." Imprisoned, unrepentant, Alessandro changed after dreaming that a radiant Maria had offered him fourteen lilies. "I've kept my promise," she smiled. "You'll be here with me someday." Upon release, he rushed to beg Assunta's forgiveness. "Jesus has forgiven you," she replied, "my Maria, too. How can I refuse?" Next morning, mother and murderer walked arm in arm to church and knelt side by side for Communion.
