

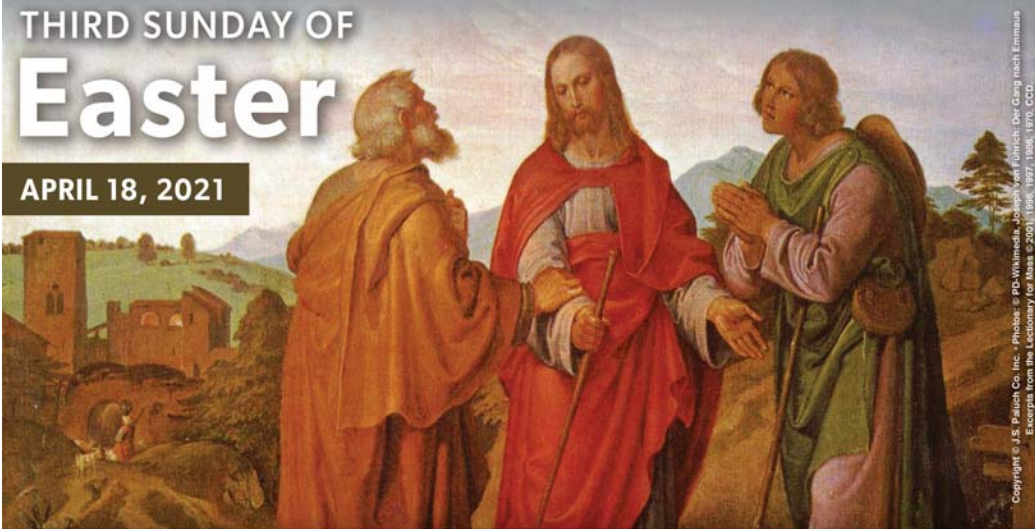

LIST KSIĘDZA PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie i Przyjaciele Kościoła

Dzisiaj Ewangelia jeszcze nas umiejscawia w niedzielę zmartwychwstania, kiedy dwóch z Emaus wraca do Jerozolimy, dołącza do pozostałych uczniów, a tam, podczas gdy to jeden, to drugi opowiada, że Pan im się ukazał, sam Zmartwychwstały staje pośród nich. Ale jego obecność wprowadza niepokój. Z jednej strony budzi trwogę, tak dalece, że zebrany „zdawało się, że widzą ducha” (Łk 24,37), z drugiej jego ciało przebite gwoździami i włócznią, jest wymownym świadectwem tego, że to Jezus ukrzyżowany we własnej osobie. Ale owo zrozumienie słowa Bożego nie jest wiedzą, którą można zdobyć prywatnie czy też w grupie swoich przyjaciół czy kolegów. Pan ujawnił sens Pism Kościołowi podczas owej wspólnoty paschalnej, przewodzonej przez Piotra i innych Apostołów, którym Nauczyciel nakazał, by głosić “nawrócenie w jego imię... wszystkim narodom” (Łk 24, 47). Niemniej, żeby być świadkami autentycznego Chrystusa, uczniowie muszą – przede wszystkim – wiedzieć jak rozpoznać jego Ciało naznaczone męką. Jeden z dawnych autorów przekazuje nam następujące zalecenie: “Każdy kto wie, iż Wielkanoc została poświęcona dla niego, musi pojąć, że jego życie zaczyna się, kiedy Jezus zmarł, aby nas zbawić?”. Ponadto apostoł musi rozumnie pojmować Pisma, czytane w świetle Ducha prawdy, który został rozlany nad Kościołem.

LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners and Friends

Today, the Gospel still refers us to the Resurrection of the Lord, when the two disciples of Emmaus are going to Jerusalem and, once there, while explaining how the Lord made himself known to them, the Resurrected appears in their midst. But his presence is disconcerting. On the one hand, it provokes a great fright on them, to the point «they thought they were seeing a ghost» (Lk 24:37) but, on the other, his body pierced by the nails and the spear. Touch me and see for yourselves that a ghost has no flesh and bones as I have» (Lk 24:39). But understanding the word of God is not something we can manage privately, or within a gathering of friends or acquaintances. The Lord revealed the meaning of the Scriptures to the Church gathered in that Paschal community presided over by Peter and the other Apostles, who had been appointed by the Master. Therefore, to be witnesses to the real Christ it is urgent that—in the first place—the disciples learn how to recognize his Passion scarred Body. An ancient author makes the following recommendation to us: «He, who understands that our Pasch has been sacrificed for him, has also to understand that his life starts when Christ died to redeem us». Furthermore, the apostle has to intelligently understand the Scriptures, read under the light of the Spirit of truth spilled over into the Church.

FULFILLMENT

It is interesting that during the Easter season, when we do not hear a reading from the Old Testament, it becomes so important. This is particularly true today. Peter's speech begins with a prayer formula familiar to Jews: "The God of Abraham . . ." (Acts 3:13). It likewise contains the potent phrases "Holy and Righteous One" and "mouth of all the prophets" (3:14, 18). Peter was stating in no uncertain terms that the law, psalms, and prophets had been fulfilled in Christ. This is reinforced by Jesus himself in the Gospel passage, when he states that everything in the scriptures (to the early Christians "the scriptures" were what we call the Old Testament) had to be fulfilled. Above all, Jesus and Peter both emphasize that we are witnesses to all of this, and are sent forth to bear witness to it in the world. The Latin Missa, from which our word "Mass" comes, means "sent" (as in "mission"). As we leave Mass today, let us remember to be witnesses to all that has been fulfilled in the risen Christ.
