Mother of Fr. Peter, Pastor of St. Hedwig's Church, has passed away at the age of 82.

Wspomnienie o mojej Mamie

+Franciszka Rożek, moja Mama, zmarła w wieku 82 lat, w sobotę 1 lutego 2020 o 7:32 rano. Jej mąż, a mój Tato Kazimierz, zmarł 13 lat temu. Obydwoje byli rolnikami. Mieli 5 dzieci: Marian (nauczyciel emeryt), Józef (emerytowany stolarz), Andrzej (mój bliźniak – rolnik), Ja Piotr, Elżbieta najmłodsza z nas (nauczycielka). Moja Mama doczekała się 11 wnuków, 8 prawnuków i 1 praprawnuczki.

Mama urodziła się 6 lipca 1937 roku. W czasie wojny zmarło jej 3 rodzeństwa. Został 1 brat. Po wojnie umarł jej ojciec, który był polskim żołnierzem w czasie II wojny światowej. To spowodowało, że Mama całe życie martwiła się o innych, a nigdy o siebie. Jej hobby to wypieki ciast i chleba oraz zbieranie grzybów w lesie. Nasze gospodarstwo jest ulokowane przy samym lesie. Uwielbiała mieć najpiękniejsze warzywa we wsi.

Kochała ludzi i uwielbiała gościć wszystkich w swoim domu. Organizowała życie kobiet we wsi, szkolenia kobiet, kursy kulinarne. Była członkinią Kółka Różańcowego. Zawsze żyła życiem lokalnego kościoła i modliła się za księży, od papieża, aż po lokalnego proboszcza. Modliła się często o powołania. Powtarzała wszystkim, aby modlili się za księży tyle samo ile o nich mówią. W jej modlitewniku była dodatkowa „Modlitwa o pokorę”. Codziennie modliła się za swojego Księdza Proboszcza z rodzinnej parafii. Bardzo cieszyła się, kiedy kilka lat temu otrzymała od Arcybiskupa lubelskiego Stanisława Budzika księgę Pisma Świętego. Czytała ją codziennie. Nawet kilkadziesiąt stron każdego dnia. Zawsze pozostanie w naszej pamięci jako kochająca Mama, zatroskana o nas wszystkich.

Pogrzeb śp. Mamy Franciszki miał miejsce we wtorek 4 lutego 2020 roku w parafii pw. Św. Mikołaja w Zakrzówku o godz. 13:00. Uroczystościom pogrzebowym przewodniczył abp lubelski Stanisław Budzik razem z moim kolegą z roku święceń bp. Arturem Mizińskim, sekretarzem Konferencji Episkopatu Polski oraz kilkadziesiąt księżmi. Mamę żegnała licznie zgromadzona Rodzina, Sąsiedzi, Parafianie i Przyjaciele. Wszystkim w Polsce i w mojej parafii we Floral Park w USA dziękuję za pamięć w modlitwie i życzliwe słowa w czasie choroby Mamy i po Jej śmierci.

Memory of my Mother

+Franciszka Rożek, my mother, died at the age of 82, on Saturday, February 1, 2020 at 7:32 in the morning. Her husband and my dad Kazimierz died 13 years ago. They were both farmers. They had five children: Marian (retired teacher), Józef (retired carpenter), Andrzej (my twin brother, farmer), myself Piotr and Elżbieta the youngest of us (teacher). My mother had 11 grandchildren, 8 great-grandchildren and 1 great-granddaughter.

My mother was born on July 6, 1937. Her three siblings died during the War. After the war, her father, a Polish soldier during World War II died. It made my mother worry all the time about others and never about herself. Her hobbies were baking cakes and bread and picking mushrooms in the woods. Our farm is located next to the forest. She loved having the most beautiful vegetables in the village.

She loved people and loved to host everyone in her home. She organized women's life in the village, women's training, and organized cooking courses. She was a member of the Rosary Altar Society. My mom always lived the life of a local church and prayed for clergy, from the pope to the local priest. She often prayed for vocations. She told everyone to pray for priests just as much as they gossip about them. There was an additional "Prayer for humility" in her prayer book. Every day she prayed for her priest from her native parish. She was very happy when a few years ago she received Bible from the Archbishop of Lublin, Stanisław Budzik. She read it every day. Even several dozen pages every day. She will always remain in our memory as a loving mother, concerned about all of us.

The funeral of the late Franciszka took place on Tuesday, February 4, 2020 in the Parish of St. Nicholas in Zakrzówek, Poland at 1.00 pm. Funeral ceremonies were presided over by Archbishop of Lublin Stanisław Budzik together with my colleague from the year of ordination: Artur Miziński, secretary of the Polish Bishops' Conference and several dozen priests. Large family, neighbors, parishioners and friends said goodbye to my mother. I thank everyone in Poland and my parish in Floral Park in the USA for remembrance in prayer and kind words during Mother's illness and after her death.

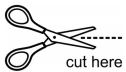
ABOUT WORLD DAY OF THE SICK

Pope John Paul II initiated the day in 1992 to encourage people to pray for those who suffer from illness and for their caregivers. The Pope himself had been diagnosed with Parkinson's a year before, in 1991, and it is considered that his own illness was impetus for his designation of the day.

World Day of the Sick was first observed on February 11, 1993. February 11 is also the Catholic Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, which a name is given to the Virgin Mary in honor of the apparitions that were said to have been seen in and around Lourdes, France, by a young girl called Bernadette Soubirous. The Church canonized Bernadette as a saint several years later.

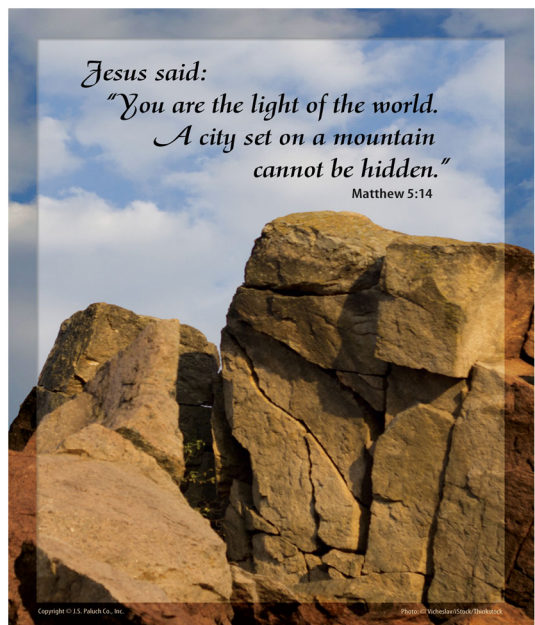
ANNUAL TELETHON

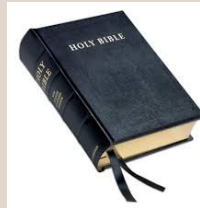
