



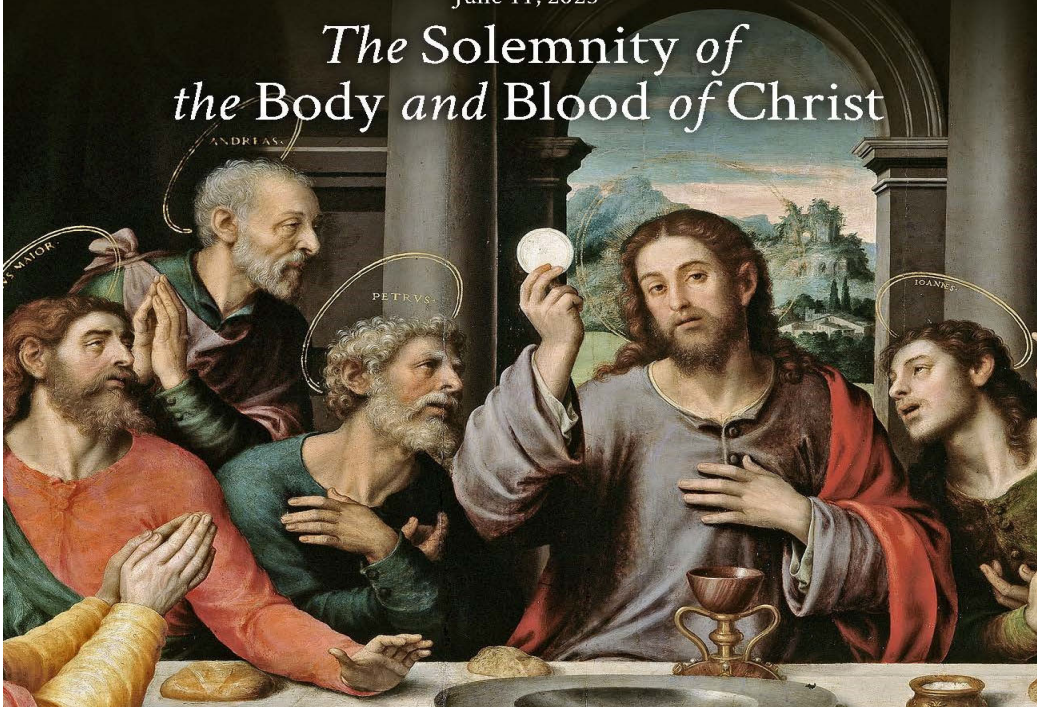

LIST KSIĘDZA PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie i Przyjaciele

Wiemy, że najważniejszym chlebem jest Jezus Chrystus. Bez Niego nie jesteśmy w stanie żyć w żaden sposób: «Beze mnie nic uczynić nie możecie» (J 15,5). Ale On sam zechciał nakarmić głodującego i, co więcej, uczynił z tego podstawowy nakaz ewangeliczny. Zapewne myślał, że jest to dobry sposób na ukazanie i potwierdzenie miłości Boga, która zbawia. Chciał także stać się dostępnym dla nas w formie chleba, abyśmy i my, którzy wciąż wędrujemy po świecie, mogli brać udział w tej miłości i w ten sposób osiągnęli życie.

Przede wszystkim chciał jednak pokazać nam, że winniśmy szukać Go i żyć Nim, chciał pokazać swoją miłość ku nam, karmiąc głodnego i dając Samego Siebie w Eucharystii: «Kto spożywa ten chleb, będzie żył na wieki» (J 6,58). Święty Augustyn komentował tę Ewangelię w niezwykle śmiały i obrazowy sposób: «Bo gdy spożywa się Chrystusa, spożywa się życie (...). Jeśli więc do tego stopnia oddalicie się od Niego, że ani Ciała ani Krwi Pańskiej spożywać nie będziecie, istnieje obawa, że umrzecie».

LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners and Friends

We know Jesus Christ is the “bread of life”. Without Him we cannot possibly live: “because without me you can do nothing” (Jn 15:5). But He Himself wanted to feed the hungry and, He made of it a fundamental evangelic must. Most surely, He thought it was a good way to reveal and affirm God's salvific love for each of us. But Jesus also wanted to become accessible to us, in the form of bread, so that we may remain in that love and thus attain life.

Above all, Jesus wanted to show us that we must seek Him and live from Him; He wanted to prove his love by feeding the hungry, offering Himself regularly in the Eucharist: “Whoever eats of this bread will live forever” (Jn 6:58). St. Augustine commented on this Gospel with daring and vivid words: "When Christ is eaten, life is eaten... If, then, you separate yourselves to the point of not taking the Body and Blood of the Lord, it is to be feared that you may die." From:Evangeli.net

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is also known as the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, which translates from Latin to "Body of Christ." This feast originated in France in the midthirteenth century and was extended to the whole Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264. This feast is celebrated on the Thursday following the Trinity Sunday or, as in the USA, on the Sunday following that feast.

This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ, the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this feast is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus' suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist.

At every Mass our attention is called to the Eucharist and the Real Presence of Christ in it. The secondary focus of this feast is upon the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with his disciples. He expresses this in the gospels by using the metaphor of a body in which He is the head. This image helps keep in focus both the unity and the diversity of the Church.

The Feast of Corpus Christi is commonly used as an opportunity for public Eucharistic processions, which serves as a sign of common faith and adoration. Our worship of Jesus in His Body and Blood calls us to offer to God our Father a pledge of undivided love and an offering of ourselves to the service of others.

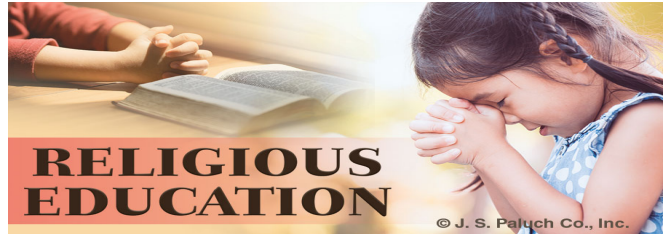
