SUNDAY REFLECTION

Today Saint Mark presents us with an avalanche of needy who approach Jesus-Savior seeking comfort and health. Even that day a man named Jairus, the head of the synagogue, made his way through the crowd to implore the health of his little daughter: "My daughter is at the point of death. Please, come lay your hands on her that she may get well and live." (Mk 5:23).

Who knows if that man knew Jesus by sight, from seeing Him frequently in the synagogue and, finding himself so desperate, decided to invoke His help. In any case, Jesus, grasping the faith of that afflicted father, agreed to his request; only while going to his house did the news come that the girl had already died and that it was useless to bother Him: "Your daughter has died; why trouble the teacher any longer?" (Mk 5:35).

Jesus, realizing the situation, asked Jairus not to be influenced by the pessimistic environment, saying: "Do not be afraid; just have faith." (Mk 5:36). Jesus asked that father for a greater faith, capable of going beyond doubt and fear. Upon arriving at Jairus' house, the Messiah brought the girl back to life with the words: "Talitha koum," which means, "Little girl, I say to you, arise!" (Mk 5:41).

We too should have more faith, that faith that does not doubt in the face of life's difficulties and trials, and that knows how to mature in pain through our union with Christ, as Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI suggests in his encyclical Spe Salvi (Saved by Hope): "It is not by sidestepping or fleeing from suffering that we are healed, but rather by our capacity for accepting it, maturing through it and finding meaning through union with Christ, who suffered with infinite love."

KATECHIZM KOŚCIOŁA KATOLICKIEGO

Jak możemy odpowiedzieć Bogu, gdy się do nas zwraca?

Odpowiedzieć Bogu to uwierzyć Mu. Kto chce wierzyć, potrzebuje „serca pełnego rozsądku” (1 Kri 3, 9). Bóg na różne sposoby próbuje się z nami skontaktować. W każdym spotkaniu z człowiekiem, w każdym kontakcie z przyrodą, w każdym pozornym przypadku, w każdym wyzwaniu, każdym cierpieniu tkwi ukryte Boże przesłanie skierowane do nas. Jeszcze wyraźniej zwraca się do nas w swoim słowie albo głosie sumienia. Mówi do nas jak do przyjaciół. Dlatego jak przyjaciele powinniśmy y odpowiedzieć i uwierzyć Mu, całkowicie Mu się powierzyć, uczyć się Go coraz lepiej rozumieć i przyjmować Jego wolę bez zastrzeżeń.



ROZWAŻANIE NA NIEDZIELE

Dzisiaj Święty Marek przedstawia tłum potrzebujących, gromadzący się wokół Jezusa Zbawiciela, poszukujący pocieszenia i zdrowia. I tego dnia przedarł się przez ten tłum człowiek o imieniu Jair, szef synagogi, by prosić o zdrowie dla swej córeczki: «Moja córeczka dogorywa, przyjdź i połóż na nią ręce, aby ocalała i żyła» (Mk 5,23).

Nikt nie wie czy ten człowiek znał Jezusa tylko z widzenia, bo widywał go w synagodze i postanowił prosić go o pomoc, gdy znalazł się w beznadziei. Tak czy owak, Jezus wyczuł wiarę tego zatroskanego ojca i odpowiedział na jego prośbę; lecz kiedy kierował się do jego domu, dotarła wiadomość, że dziewczynka zmarła i nie miało sensu go już fatygować: «Twoja córka umarła, czemu jeszcze trudzisz Nauczyciela?» (Mk 5,35).

ezus zaś, zdając sobie sprawę z sytuacji, poprosił Jaira, aby nie poddał się atmosferze pesymizmu i rzekł do niego: «Nie bój się, wierz tylko!» (Mk 5,36). Jezus poprosił tego ojca o większą wiarę, wiarę zdolną wznieść się ponad wątpliwości i strach. A po przybyciu do domu Jaira Mesjasz przywrócił dziewczynce życie takimi słowami: «Talitá kum, co oznacza: ‘Dziewczynko, mówię ci, wstań!’» (Mk 5,41). Także my powinniśmy mieć większą wiarę, taką która nie wątpi w momentach trudności i życiowych prób, i która potrafi dojrzewać w bólu poprzez naszą łączność z Chrystusem, zgodnie z tym co proponował papież Benedykt XVI w swojej encyklice Spe Salvi (Nadzieją zbawieni): «Nie unikanie cierpienia ani ucieczka od bólu uzdrawia człowieka, ale zdolność jego akceptacji, dojrzewania w nim, prowadzi do odnajdywania sensu przez zjednoczenie z Chrystusem, który cierpiał z nieskończoną miłością».
